Topic: Co-creating with Stakeholders in Pursuing Age-friendly Community: Case Studies

The 1.5 million Hong Kong citizens aged 65-year-old or above come from a wide spectrum of socio-economic backgrounds, and thus there is a wide diversity of needs. To pursue an age-friendly community, we put the elderlies at the centre of designing our social innovation projects, and co-create with different stakeholders to fulfill the needs of older people. In this sharing, we illustrate our thinking and care for the community in the design process in three cases: a Recycling Trolley and Socially-Inclusive Waste Management Hub for grassroots elderly workers, as well as an Interactive Voice Response Robot designed for use in an elderly centre.

主題:案例分享:與社區持份者共創年齡友善社會

同樣是年長人士,近150萬 65歲或以上的香港長者有著不同的社會及經濟背景,他們的需要也複雜多樣。要構建年齡友善的社會,我們以年長者為中心,與社區的持份者合力設計不同的方案,滿足長者的需要。是次演講,將以 JCDISI為基層年長工友設計的回收手推者與社區共融廢物處理中心;以及在長者中心服務精靈活潑銀髮族的語音互動機械人為案例,闡述我們的關懷與思考。
